Your advocate

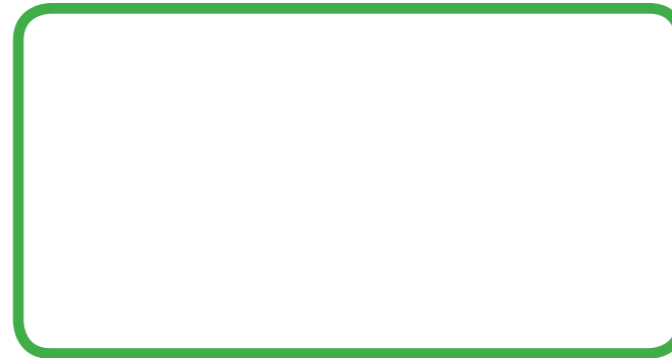
